Prestonwood Baptist Has Inaugural Service

Prestonwood Baptist Church officially returned to North Dallas on Sunday with its 11 a.m. inaugural service at the church's new Dallas campus at 12123 Hillcrest Road.

Prestonwood has deep roots on Hillcrest Road. The church was born in 1977 at Beltline and Hillcrest roads. Later, it moved to Hillcrest and Arapaho roads, in what is now the Shelton School campus.

In 1999, the church moved from tight quarters to a bigger campus in Plano.

Prestonwood has 30,000 members at three campuses now, including one in Prosper.

Pastor Jack Graham told an overflow crowd of about 2,300 that this is a new beginning for Prestonwood, as the church returns to its roots.

“Six months ago we had no clue that this was going to happen,” Graham said. “But God moves instantaneously, miraculously and powerfully in ways we can't even understand, and that's exactly what has happened here.”
