

How did you originate the name of your company, The Wildworks Group?

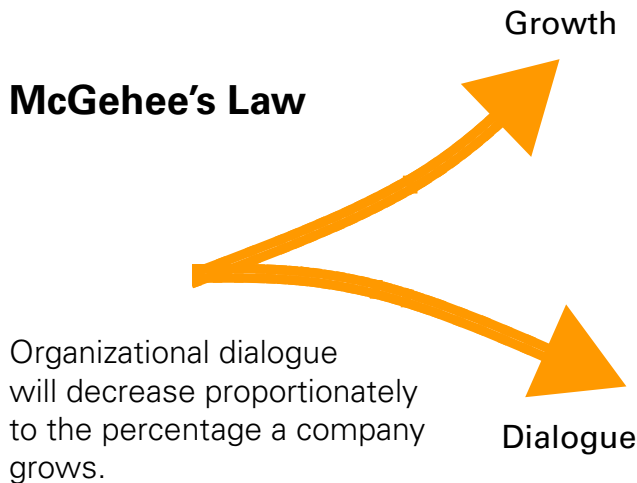
“Wild” comes from the book, *Wild at Heart*, by John Eldridge.
